Smart Goals:

Attendance Goal: During the 2024-2025 school year, Fort Hall Elementary students, kindergarten through fifth grade, will average at least 90% attendance.

iStation ELA Goal: During the 2024-2025 we will increase the percentage of students scoring at or above benchmark on the IRI/CBM fluency assessment by 7% from Fall to Spring from 47% to 54%.

ISAT ELA Goal: During the 2024-2025 school year, Fort Hall Elementary students, third through fifth grade, will increase by 7%, from 12% Proficient or Above to 19% Proficient or Above.

Imagine Math Goal: During the 2024-2025 school year, Fort Hall Elementary students, Kindergarten through fifth grade, will increase from 7% on quantile score for individual students K-2.

ISAT Math Goal: During the 2024-2025 school year, Fort Hall Elementary students, third through fifth grade, will increase from 9% Proficient or Above to 16% Proficient or Above on the Summative ISAT for Math.

Leadership Goal: During the 2024-2025 school year, the Leadership Team at Fort Hall Elementary will meet bi-weekly to report on the data and growth discussed in PLC Team Meetings and to collaborate with the parent representative. The Leadership Team will then decide on professional development and strategies to fill the holes in the academic areas of ELA and Math, as well as possible activities to increase morale in students and staff.
